The state of your numbers

I once asked a tradie, "how's business" and he replied, "I'm not sure, the accountants haven't done the tax yet"

Ok, "what information & targets do you use to manage the business?"

Turns out he had no targets, basing decisions on the bank balance, job book & monies owing."

The bottom line: he didn't really understand the state of his business because he lacked the critical numbers; but he found a way to survive.

I contend while the accountant's report may be great for tax, it's useless for management!

My counsel for business owners:

SET YOUR OWN TARGETS...

- 1. The most important being Gross Profit
- 2. Then, at month-end put your manager's hat on and review the numbers...
 - ...Did we achieve the GP target this month?
 - ... If not, are we on track YTD?
 - ...If you're below target, find out why and how you will get back on track

Calculating your GROSS PROFIT is simple...you just need two numbers:

Q: How much you want to earn before tax, assume:	\$1	00,000
Plus, operating expenses, assume:	<u>\$2</u>	00,000
= GROSS PROFIT for the next 12 months:	<mark>\$3</mark>	<mark>00,000</mark>
<mark>Per MONTH</mark>	\$	<mark>25,000</mark>
Per WEEK	\$	5,770
Per DAY	\$	1,000

In addition...

Retailers: Should also set a target for the NUMBER OF SALES based on average GP/sale

Service businesses: Should also set a target for the NUMBER OF LABOUR HOURS to be invoiced based on average rate/hour.

So, what would your answer be if I asked you, "how's business?"
