An ASIC review of the banks recently appeared in a major newspaper under the banner, "Heartless lenders ignore desperate customers" and included such findings as...

- Hardship complaints have soared in recent times

While the ASIC review mainly focused on home loans, the debt-slave principle also applies to business loans.

And being a lender's slave puts all your assets at risk of seizure if you default.

My counsel for business owners:

- 1. Make it your goal to get out of debt, not to increase debt
- 2. Don't add to your mortgage debt with a new car, caravan or holiday
- 3. Instead of borrowing consider other options such as forgoing the purchase
- 4. Read the loan documents carefully so you understand what it means to be a slave.

Our earthly assignment is to live as debt-free servants of Jesus, abiding by His Word, NOT to be enslaved by the world's money-lenders!

THE BIBLE, our HANDBOOK, counsel for today: Proverbs 22:7 (Holman CSB) ...

"The rich rule over the poor and the borrower is a slave to the lender"

Note the 1st warning - The RICH own the banks and use debt to rule over the POOR

And the 2nd - Borrowers become slaves of the rich making them even richer through usury.

Please don't ignore these warnings!
