Doing the right work

In the end, business success is a numbers game.

Anecdotal evidence suggests only 4% achieve great success; 16%, good success; 30% plod along in survival mode; and 50% fail.

In four decades of studying, observing & advising business owners, I've uncovered several reasons for these appalling statistics, including...

- 1: The owner's startup research & assumptions were wrong, yet they still went ahead
- 2: They lacked a clear vision to lead them and their team to a better future
- 3: Their marketing messages lacked one crucial element, that is to communicate love.

And for Christian owners, for some reason there is a reluctance to learn and apply Biblical principles to their operation and decision-making.

My counsel for business owners:

It's natural to dream of great success; few achieve it because in the main they're doing the wrong work which leads them to build the wrong model, one overly-dependent on themselves.

Put in Titanic terms...these owners are trapped in the bow of the ship shoveling coal, instead of being up in the birds-nest watching for icebergs!

So, wherever you are in terms of those success-fail stats, it's not too late to move up a notch or two; but it requires repentance, that is a change of mindset & direction.

As leader, you need to do the right work, including...

- 1: Articulate, write and share your God-ordained vision for the business
- 2: Treat the business as your product while the team treats what you sell as their product
- 3: Invest 70+% of your time on strategy, identifying **opportunities** for improvement and **threats** to the business future...and there's plenty of them emerging almost daily!

The Bible, our Handbook counsel for today, Proverbs 21:25, NIRV...

"Some people will die while they are still hungry. That's because their hands refuse to work"

Consider this verse in the natural, that is in relation to business ownership:

- ...To DIE means business failure
- ...To be HUNGRY means poor profitability
- ...To REFUSE TO WORK not only means doing the wrong work but working for the wrong person, that is yourself, instead of Jesus the rightful owner!
