# What's in your hand?

Remember in Exodus 3, God called Moses to confront Pharaoh and demand he let the Israelites go.

Moses was hesitant and sought a sign that he could do it; so, the LORD asked him, "What's that in your hand?" (Exodus 4:2) and Moses replied, "a stick" (NLV).

Then, "throw it on the ground" and as he did, it turned into a serpent.

# Moses got his sign; and we got three lessons...

- 1: Expect amazing outcomes when our actions align with the will of God
- 2: We should focus on what we have, not on what we don't have
- 3: Expect to receive several of these hand moments in life!

#### My counsel for business owners:

Psalm 139:14 declares we are all 'fearfully and wonderfully made' thus, you're not a nobody, your life matters; God has put a gift in your hand.

The question is, do you know what it is? If not, ask Him for revelation & confirmation.

Maybe it's an idea to make the world a better place; or your industry; a revolutionary new product or service; an invention; a ministry; a career; a desire to create great things; or teach others.

Whatever it is, it's unique to you so, be wary of coveting what's in someone else's hand!

- \* David had a slingshot in his hand...and defeated a giant (1 Samuel 17)
- \* With a few speckled sheep, Jacob built a dynasty & great wealth (Genesis 30)
- \* In Acts 3, Peter had only the authority of Jesus name and healed the cripple.
- \* Nick Vujicic was born with a disability, yet it hasn't stopped him impacting countless lives with his message see <a href="https://www.nickvujicic.com">www.nickvujicic.com</a> ...
