What's in your hand?

Remember in Exodus 4:1-5, God called Moses to tell Pharaoh to free the Israelites?

Moses felt he wasn't qualified for the assignment and sought a sign that he was; so, the LORD asked, "What's that in your hand?" and Moses replied, "a stick" (NLV).

Then, "throw it on the ground" and as he did, it turned into a snake.

Moses got his sign; and we got TWO lessons...

- 1: Expect amazing outcomes when you align with God's plan
- 2: Focus on what you do have instead of what you don't have.

My counsel for business owners:

Psalm 139:14 declares that we are 'wonderfully made.'

You're not a nobody, your life matters; God has given you something unique to use for his glory.

My question: do you know what it is? If not, ask Him for revelation & confirmation in scripture.

It may be a business idea; a vision for a better world; a new product or service; an invention; a way to disrupt an industry; a desire to teach others; a ministry; or none of the above!

* And be wary of coveting what's in someone else's hand!

David had a slingshot...and changed history!

Nick Vujicic (Vooyi-chich) was born with a severe disability, yet it hasn't stopped him impacting the lives of others through his message...

"If God can use a man without arms and legs to be His hands and feet, then He will certainly use any willing heart"

God gave me a spiritual gift of teaching that manifests as a natural gift in my hand - "to see through the murky waters of business, a clear path."

Again, I ask, what's in your hand? It's part of God's plan for your life, don't waste it.
