Everything in life, business and the kingdom is binary, either 'this' or 'that' - black or white, there is no grey!

Applying this principle to the marketplace explains why so many business owners and their operation are performing way below their full potential; and spend too much time running round in circles 'doing stuff' and hoping everything works-out sales and profit-wise.

We have shared many reasons for this in our Handbook sessions but one stands out, and that is where Jesus asserts, *"If anyone serves Me, let him follow me...and...him my Father will honour"*

- * We honour the Father by believing in, serving, and following His Son, our Saviour, (the true owner of your operation) and His Word, the Holy Bible
- * In return He honours us; that is values, reveres and rewards in the spiritual & the natural.

My counsel for you, as a business owner:

Understand, in every interaction you have with prospects, customers, staff or suppliers, Jesus is already there in Spirit expecting you to act on His behalf. Therefore...

...consider Him either as part of the conversation or as the person you're actually speaking with; with that in mind...do you think you might do or say things a bit different?

If you leave Jesus out of the equation, out of business decisions, out of your future then you walk alone limiting the Father's honour because you're acting for your own benefit.

It also means you've likely succumbed to the Babylonian system with its end-goal to enslave & destroy you, as per John 10:10 and Revelation 18:13.

Babylon is cunning and deceptive, enticing Christians to leave Jesus at church after the Sunday service not realising that we are the church and everywhere we go He's already there, waiting!

The bottom line: to build a great business, that honours God and overcomes the Babylonian attack, invite Jesus onto the team...and position Him as leader; then failure is not an option!

...then the Father's honour can flow in the form of business success...and ultimately, freedom.
